Mulberry	Illinois Everbearing	7 gal	Zone 5. Dark green, tropical-like foliage. Fruit seedless, good for eating and cooking. Mature size 25-30'. Self-pollinating.

Pawpaw	Native American	2 gal	
Pawpaw	Native American	3 gal	Zone 5. Exotic, banana flavor w/creamy flesh. Purple flowers prior to large tropical looking foliage. Mature height 12-15'. Two seedling pawpaws will cross pollinate.
Peach	Belle of Georgia (White Flesh)	7 gal	
Peach	Blushingstar (White Flesh)	7 gal	Zone 5. Matures late season. Firm, white flesh peach. Best for eating, shipping, storing. Self-pollinating. Freestone.

Peach	Contender	7 gal	Zone 4. Ripens mid-late Auguste. Med. to lg. peach. Spring pink flowers - attracts bees. Red fruit - sweet. Freestone.

Peach	Cresthaven	7 gal	Zone 5. Late season peach. yellow flesh, juicy and firm. Best for eating, canning, cooking. Freestone. Self-pollinating.
Peach	July Elberta	7 gal	Zone 5. Matures mid-season. Large juicy yellow fleshed peach. Best for eating, canning, freezing.

Pear	Anjou (European)	7 gal	Zone 5. High quality winter pear. Fruit bright green, yellow at maturity. Best for eating, winter keeping. Must be pollinated by another European pear.
Pear	Asian Espalier Three Tier	15 gal	
Pear	Bartlett (European)	7 gal	Zone 5. Smooth, buttery flesh is sweet. Best for eating, cooking, canning. Must be pollinated by another European pear, except Seckel.
Pear	Bosc (European)	7 gal	

Pear	Chojuro (Asian)	7 gal	Zone 4. Early bearing, medium-to-large, flattened golden-brown fruit. Best for salads eating cannon. Must be pollinated by another Asian pear.
Pear	Comice (European)	7 gal	Zone 5. Rich flavored dessert pear. Golden yellow tinged with hint of red. Best for eating, salads, baking. Must be pollinated by another European pear.
Pear	European Espalier Three Tier	15 gal	
Pear	Kieffer (European)	7 gal	Zone 4. Matures late. Large green-yellow pear. Best for eating, winter keeping. Will pollinate othe european pears.

Pear	Red Anjou (European)	7 gal	Zone 5. Fine textured pear, golden-white flesh. Mild and juicy. Skin deep red getting brighter as it ripens. Best for eating, winter keeping. Must be pollinated by another European pear.

Persimmon	Native American	7 gal	Zone 5. Mature at 20-25'. Fruit is astringent and should ripen before eating. Attracts bees, wildlife. Plant multiple seedlings for proper pollination.

Plum	Santa Rosa (Japanese)	7 gal	
Plum	Satsuma (Japanese)	7 gal	Zone 5. Very sweet, medium sized fruit with oval shape. Best for eating, desserts, snaks, canning. Best if pollinated by another Japanese plum.
